June Club Meeting

The June club meeting will be held at the usual time of **6:00 PM** on the first **Thursday** of the month, **June 5**. We will meet at the Edmonds Public Library and the meeting will be available virtually via Google Meet. Spanky will send an email invitation to regular attendees prior to the meeting. June Club Dive - Redondo

Spanky found that weekend tides for the month of June were not conducive for diving at any of our current-sensitive sites. Therefore, we decided to return to a well-known dive site that is good for diving under almost all circumstances. We will meet at **Redondo** at **9:00 AM on Sunday, June 1**. Our entry time will be **10:00 AM**. This site is familiar to most club members. It is common to find wolf eels, gunnels, red octopuses, and GPOs. It is also known for the occasional sixgill shark. After the dive we will reconvene at Jimmy Mac's Roadhouse for some lunch.

Directions to Redondo:

Take I 5 to Exit 147 and head west on S 272nd St. After about a mile the road curves left and then becomes Marine View Dr. Continue winding down the hill (road will change to 10th and then 281st).

At the waterfront, veer left on Beach Drive and proceed to the 3-way stop just past Salty's.

Turn left and park along the street for free or in the pay lot to your right. Entry for the dive is across the street from the northwest corner of the parking lot.

Alternatively, you can tell Google Maps to guide you to Redondo Park Beach, Fishing Pier, and Boat Launch.

It was Cinco De Mayo Eve and a beautiful day for a dive, and the Tacoma Marathon. After being detoured through Old Town Tacoma, we arrived at Les Davis for the dive. There was little wind to disturb the surface and it was a nice swim out to where we decided to drop. Due to Spanky's excellent navigation, we dropped almost on top of the 1st set of cement slabs and started checking them out. Visibility was really good, easily better than 30 feet and no current. There was a wolf eel just hanging out on the bottom, not in a hole and not swimming, a sighting that was a first for us. We saw a number of nice nudibranchs, 6 different species (don't ask me to name them), some ling cod, flounder, shrimp, clams, moon snails, perch and many rockfish. Unfortunately, there were no octopuses,

buffalo sculpin, or seahorse sightings. The office chair at 70 feet is no longer there. During the swim back to shore, a fish grabbed one of the lures that a diver was carrying after finding it on the dive. Imagine its disappointment! All in all, a very nice dive.
